Some of the responses to the 'Save the Stars' Petition (Bishops Castle, Shropshire)

I worked in Stars News as a paper boy at 14 and then at 16 behind the counter. After a time I became the relief manager. This building holds the memory of my teenage years!

We used to live above the Stars. It breaks my heart to see any building so neglected especially on the high street. Bishops Castle needs a barbers and it could be used to help train youngsters.

This central building could be a part of a thriving community - there are a number of ideas brought forward by the community that are worthy of consideration. Local-specific research carried out by Otago Polytechnic University has identified several key issues for Bishops Castle that have impacts on the health and wellbeing of the community and this space could help to address some of these - in particular issues with mental health and social isolation, alcohol and substance abuse and youth mental health.

If the County Council support this local initiative by a tried and trusted group, Bishops Castle will benefit in a number of ways: a building within a conservation area will be saved from increasingly expensive neglect; the town's affordable housing stock will be expanded; the mixture of retail, residential and community use -the Holy Grail of all town centres- will be extended. This business failed to prosper. It's time we dealt constructively with the sad neglect which has resulted from that failure.

As a regular visitor to your town. I think this is a clever idea to offer affordable accommodation and support for the community. Clearly, an improvement to the appearance of the building can only enhance the existing charm of the town in general.

Please arrange so that it may be purchased by the town in order to save it.
